- Maximum Tuition & Unlimited Classes: Tuition is capped at the rate of \$2,749.95/semester for all Academic students enrolled in at least 14 hours of classes per week.
- All Advanced dancers are eligible to participate in VBC's annual production of The Nutcracker, Spring performance and Precedence.
- Virginia Ballet Company: Advanced students are eligible to join the Virginia Ballet Company (the Company). Students wishing to be considered as a Member of the Company are required to audition in both Classical Ballet and Modern Technique before admittance is considered. Students invited to join the Company and their parents will need to sign a Company Contract describing class enrollment, class attendance and performance obligations.

Students wishing to be considered as a Member of the Company are required to audition in both Classical Ballet and Modern Technique before admittance is considered.
