**Notes:**

- All students new to Virginia Ballet Company and School must take a free trial placement class. Students are placed into levels based on knowledge and ability. Please call to schedule a placement class.
- It is recommended that dancers invest in 2 classes/week, unless informed otherwise by the Artistic Staff, to continue to improve in knowledge, technique, and musicality.
- Dancers will be evaluated quarterly with a final evaluation at the end of the academic year to determine readiness to progress to the next level. Progression is not automatic as dancers must demonstrate proficiency in understanding the necessary skills needed for advancement.
- Beginning Ballet I dancers are eligible to participate in VBC’s annual production of Nutcracker in December and the end-of-year recital, Promenade, in June.
- Separate performance fees are required to participate in productions with additional days/times for rehearsals.
